PRE- OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO ARRIVING AT OUR OFFICE

- Know your medical history, including past and current illnesses, health conditions, medications, allergies, and any complications with previous surgeries or anesthesia
- Parent / Guardian must be present for minors (under 18 years old)

IF YOU ARE PLANNING TO BE SEDATED

- NO FOOD OR DRINK for 8 hours before sedation. Medications that you normally take may be taken with a small sip of water.
- If you use an inhaler for asthma or similar conditions, PLEASE bring this with you to your procedure.
- If you use injection insulin, please discuss if a change in dosing is necessary with your surgeon in advance.
- Wear a short-sleeved t-shirt or one that allows the sleeves to easily be rolled up. Do NOT wear contact lenses. Please remove all piercings (ex. earring, tongue rings, etc.) before arrival.
- Bring a responsible adult with you on the day of surgery who will stay in our office during the surgery, drive you home afterwards, and remain with you during your recovery from anesthesia.
